The Home Energy Rebates Program Saves Americans Money

The Home Energy Rebates Program can reduce energy bills for nearly 5 million American families, reduce American energy costs by ~\$3.2 billion annually, save American families significantly on their energy bills, create over 180,000 jobs across the country and increase American energy dominance.

Home Energy Rebates Programs have launched in 13 states across the country. These programs are delivering rebates to American households, with 35,864 projects completed and more than \$33 million reserved for in progress projects.

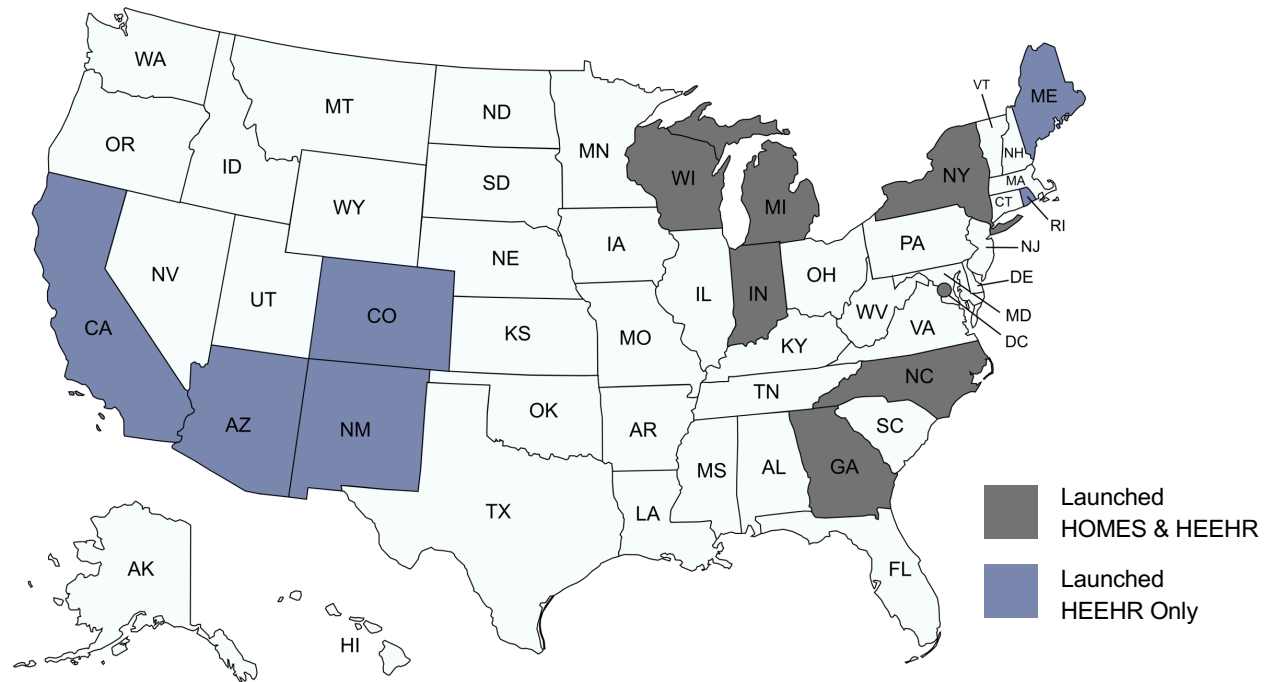

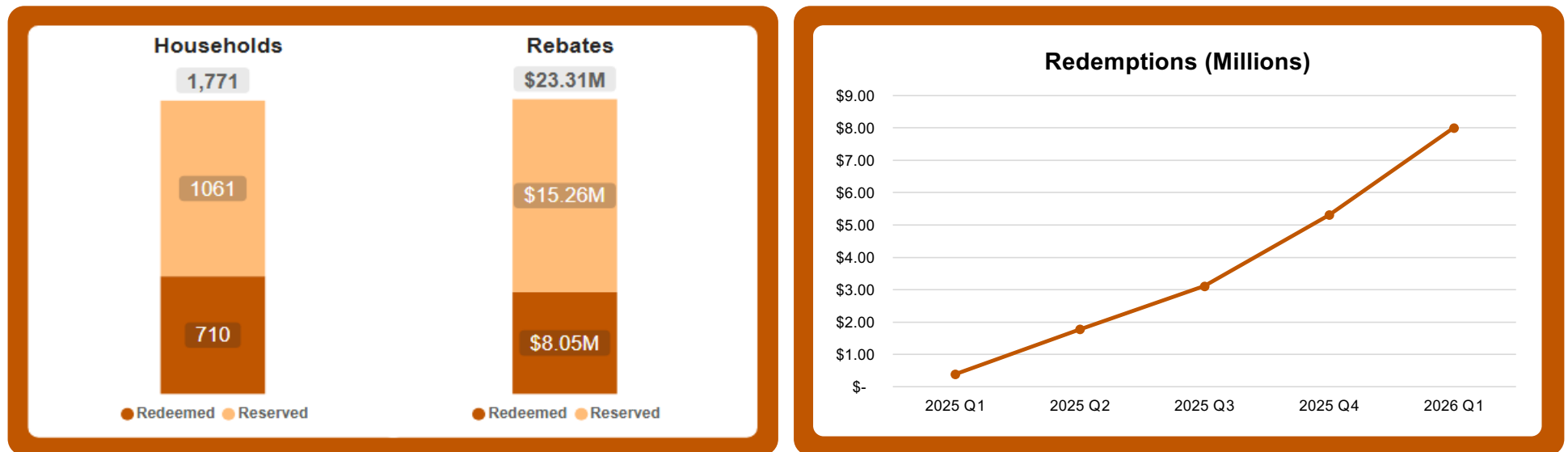

There are 7 launched programs across the country that are reserving and redeeming HOMES rebates every day. These programs continue to increase rebate redemptions and have delivered over \$8M to over 710 households.

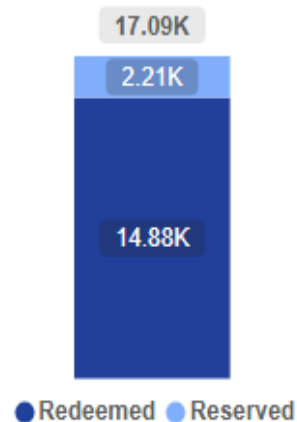


HEEHR Programs are Reaching Homeowners

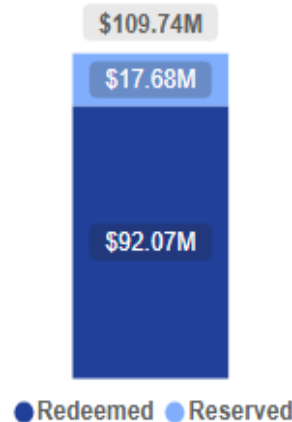

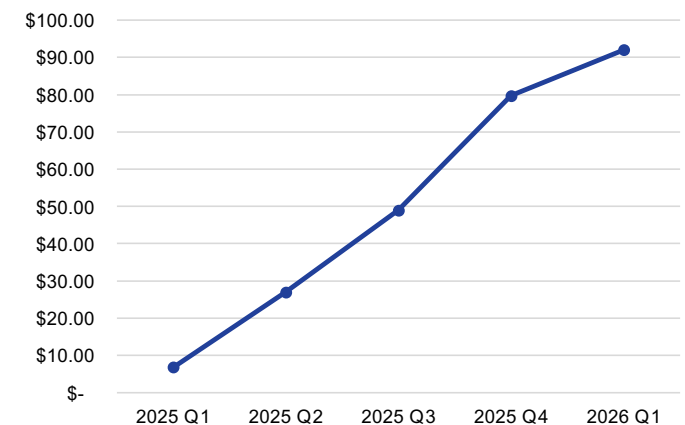

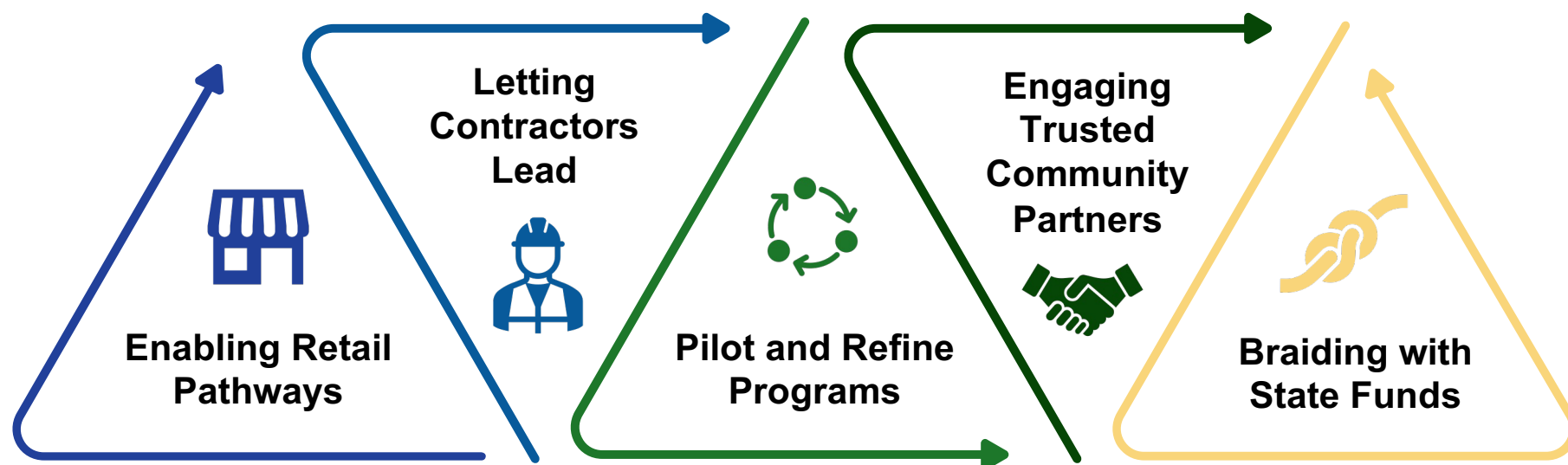


Redemptions (Millions)



Launched Programs Include Several Program Designs

States designed programs to meet their unique needs and employed different strategies based on their **local context and resident's needs**.



Wisconsin: Focus on Energy

Delivering Savings

Focus on Energy partners with natural gas and electric utilities, keeping administrative costs low and maximizing funds for homeowners, and has operated in WI for over 25 years.

Rebates Reserved & Redeemed

Reaching Multifamily Buildings

Six multi-family low-income projects had HOMES modeled savings of ~280,000 kWh or 11,667 kWh per unit, which is **more than the annual consumption of an average U.S. household.**

Streamlined Access to Upgrades

Residents and contractors can purchase appliances in-store or online at small and medium retailers through a **mail-in rebate pathway** and receive instant discounts at Lowe's through a **point-of-sale rebate pathway.**

Georgia: GEFA

Improving Home Comfort, Efficiency, & Value

Funds are providing relief to Americans: 86% of rebate dollars distributed to date went to low-income households, helping reduce their energy burden and freeing up income for other essential needs.

Contractors Connect Residents to Upgrades

As a contractor led program, GEFA works with **over 100 trained contractors** across the state, driving economic activity while providing savings to Americans.

Partnering with Retailers and Offering DIY options

GEFA partnered with **Home Depot** to offer a **DIY retail pathway** to upgrade kitchen appliances. This partnership boosts consumer choice, promotes American made products, and enables families to replace their appliances when they break.

North Carolina: Energy Saver NC

Investing in Communities & Building Resilience

Designed to help the nearly 1.4 million residents that are spending a high fraction of their incomes on energy bills, this program focuses on areas with high energy burdens, including rural and underserved communities.

Energy Saver NC conducts a home assessment to create a custom action plan to increase comfort and enhance homes, combining HOMES and HEEHR programs to provide a **simplified experience for homeowners and contractors.**

This program was rolled out in phases to provide support to communities directly affected by hurricane flooding and damage.
